Tulsa energy company to put plant in Halstead

SemGroup, a Tulsa-based energy company, is building a polymer-modified asphalt plant in an industrial park in Halstead.

Construction is expected to begin before the end of the year and the plant is scheduled to be operational by spring. The plant will have at least five employees, the company said.

The plant, which has access to both highway and rail, will serve construction crews in Kansas, Missouri and Colorado.

The plant is the outgrowth of SemGroup's recent purchase of assets in Kansas and Oklahoma from Butaphalt Technologies International, which included the land in Halstead.
